



Students Entering 1st - 5th Grades:

Welcome to Bookopolis.com !

This summer, students entering Grades 1-5 are invited to use Bookopolis.com, an online community of young readers, where they can:

- 1) Find the "just-right" books for them.
- 2) Enjoy sharing their summer reading selections with their grade-level class friends.

Your student already has a Bookopolis.com account that has been created under Holy Redeemer School's name. Our school librarian, Ann Enkiri, is a member of each grade-level class (1-5) and each grade's teachers have been invited to join as well. Your student has been assigned a **User Name and Password** which was sent home on a Summer Reading bookmark. *If you need help with your child's account, please email Ann Enkiri at a.enkiri@hrs-ken.org.*

With a parent's help, students can log into their account from any computer or tablet. All of the students in each grade level (1-5) class are connected as "Friends" on the site so they can see each other's bookshelves and book reviews.

At Bookopolis.com, students can:

- Create virtual bookshelves of books that they have read, are reading now, or want to read.
- Rate and review books to practice opinion writing.
- Recommend books to classmates.
- Track daily or weekly reading in an online reading log (including a timer).
- Connect with classmates to see what books they've read.
- Explore new book ideas and reviews from curated lists.
- Earn points and badges for their reading achievements.
- Complete book reports to practice comprehension and critical thinking.

(Note: Book reports are not required!)

Building a love of reading continues to be one of our top priorities at Holy Redeemer Catholic School.
